

New Asbestos Operative Training

The Control of Asbestos at Work Regulations place a duty of care on landlords and property managers to ensure that contact with any asbestos containing material is restricted to trained, competent people. Asbestos can be found in a variety of materials, from its most friable form in insulation to relatively low risk compounds such as resins. This course informs employees on how to identify asbestos containing materials and what to do if it is found.

It is particularly relevant for workers whose daily activities can bring them into contact with asbestos containing materials, and a potential fibre release. Examples are:
